

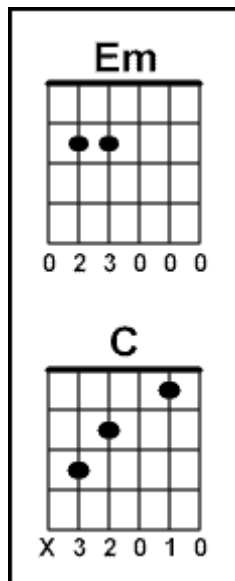
How to add chords to SightReader For Guitar 1.2?

There is file called "Chords.txt" in the install directory of the SightReader For Guitar 1.2. If you installed it on your device, the file would be under "\Program Files\SightReader For Guitar".

The file format looks like these:

[Chord Name]:[String Number],[Fret Number],[Finger Number];[String Number],[Fret Number],[Finger Number];[String Number],[Fret Number],[Finger Number]...

"0" for open string. One line each chord. There is no spaces between numbers.



To add new chords showed on the left, for example, you add the following two lines to the file:

Em:6,0,0;5,2,2;4,2,3;3,0,0;2,0,0;1,0,0

C:5,3,3;4,2,2;3,0,0;2,1,1;1,0,0

(You only play 5 strings for C major)

Before you make any change to the Chords.txt file, make sure to make a copy. Also make a copy of the changed file so you don't lose your changes in case you have to reinstall the software.
